Application Customization Stockpile The stockpile compaction feature package has been created for Dressta's crawler dozer series to manage job situations that include sloped locations that are often unstable. A reinforced Dressta steel drum is one of the main pieces of equipment for the SFR equipment complete with a winch line attachment consisting of brackets connecting to the drum. There is a tensioning apparatus that prevents the line from coming into contact with the slope face. A cleaning system and precision guide are part of the machine.
